NFPW Announces Top Honors to Two Members

Clara Cartrette of North Carolina and **Cary Herz** of New Mexico were honored during a banquet as part of NFPW's annual conference, this year hosted by Media Network Idaho.

Cartrette was a founding member and key organizer of North Carolina Press Club. She credits it and organizations like NFPW for training. The award was the culmination of her 47-year journalism career.
