What is POPPS? Who can join? Why should you join?

POPPS (Parley of Past Presidents State) or, as originally called, Pooped Out Past Presidents, is a group of past state affiliate presidents who want to be informed, stay in the loop, and continue to be an important part of NFPW leadership.

Members are a kind of “auxiliary” to NFPW at conferences. Our members assist in registration, introduction of speakers, taking meal tickets, being “gophers” and helping conference planners in any way needed.

Founded in 1972, POPPS meets once a year. Dues are \$10 a year and pay for printing and postage of an annual newsletter. Each year a donation is made to the NFPW Education Fund and Endowment Fund. POPPS also provides minor funding and volunteers for a hospitality area to meet and greet conference attendees and answer questions.
